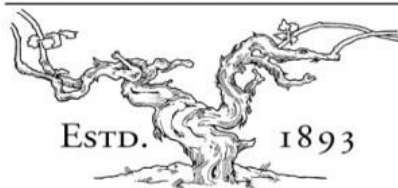

2014 Barbera d'Anunda

Grape Variety: 100% Barbera

Vineyard Soils: Red brown earth / sandy loam over red clay

Vine Age: Barbera planted 2005

GI: Barossa Valley

Summary:

Barbera is a well-known Italian grape variety. Barbera d'Anunda takes its name from its home town appellation, Tanunda, in the Barossa Valley, and its un-canny similarities with Barbera d'Alba – the famous appellation for Barbera in the Piedmont, Italy. A play on words, but the variety is true to Australian Barbera character.

Vinification:

Fruit was hand-picked, put to open fermenters and hand plunged four times per day for 7 days. After malolactic fermentation, matured was in 2 & 3 year old French barriques. No fining or filtration.

ALC 13 % **pH** 3.4 **TA** 6.2 g/l

Tasting Note:

Colour: Bright purple-red.

Nose: Lifted aromatics of spice and sour cherries.

Palate: Medium bodied yet elegant with bright red fruits, spice and floral notes.

Notes: Enjoy slightly chilled in hot weather or match with your favourite foods.
