What, for you, sets this red wine apart?

Vineyard sets this wine apart: single-vineyard wine made with fruit sourced from Kaesler 1893 block of shiraz, yielding less than two tonne to the acre, hand pruned and picked. These vines have deep roots that contribute to greater uptake of minerals, which adds to the complexity of the wine. A powerful wine with elegance on the palate, it has decades to give.

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2012 Kaesler Old Bastard Barossa Valley Shiraz

Sourced from a block on the estate vineyard at Nuriootpa planted in 1893; hand-picked and matured in French oak (35% new, 65% 1yo); vinification 'a closely guarded secret'. A fragrant bouquet of red, purple and black fruits tightly spun together in a fine coat of black chocolate; shares the medium-bodied elegance of Alte Reben, and even more freshness on the lingering finish. A special wine. 14.5% alc.
