KAESLER OLD VINE SHIRAZ 2008

Ninety Two points, Robert Parker's Wine Advocate
Ninety Three points, Gary Walsh – Winefront

The 2008 Old Vine Shiraz is blended from 3 Kaesler Estate vineyards, aged 60 and 40 years. It has been matured in French Oak for 18 months. It is bottled without fining or filtration.

This wine is restrained in its youth but will open and mature over the next 10 years.

Colour: Opaque strong black core with rim displaying vibrant cherry hues.

Nose: Aromas of blackberry, aniseed, loganberry and cedar.

Palate: Ripe blackberry and plum fruit with supporting flavours of aniseed and blueberries and malty oak. Firm grainy tannins are perfectly balanced by acid and fruit.

Notes: Tightly wound and structured. The balance and poise between fruit and tannins ensures fabulous cellaring potential.

Age of vines: Estate plantings 60 & 40 years of age.
