



2010 Clare Wine Co Watervale Riesling

Kaesler own vineyards in the Watervale and Polish Hill sub-regions of the Clare Valley. The 2010 Clare Wine Co Riesling is the first release from the Clare Valley estate, owned by Kaesler wines & the fruit is sourced from the Watervale vineyard. **Colour:** Vibrant cherry red.

Colour: Pale straw colour.

Nose: Fresh limes with hints of stonefruit notes such as nectarine.

Palate: Quite rich for a younger wine. Nice citrus flavours, with a bit of sugar, just to take the sting out of the acid. Mouthfilling, well structured palate.

Notes: A very easy drinking style of wine. An excellent drink in its youth or will cellar for the next 5 -8 years. Being Riesling and a fuller style at that, get it as cold as you can, and don't worry about it being to cold, you'll be on the patio, reclining in the Banana lounge, flicking from the tennis to the cricket.
