



2010 Clare Wine Co Rose

Kaesler own vineyards in the Watervale and Polish Hill sub-regions of the Clare Valley.

The 2010 Clare Wine Co Rose is the first release from the Clare Valley estate, owned by Kaesler wines & the fruit is sourced from the Polish Hill vineyard.

The Clare Wine Co Rose is a blend of Shiraz (55%) and Cabernet Sauvignon (45%). The wine was cold soaked for 5 days before starting ferment and was then pressed off and finished in tank.

Colour: Ruby garnet.

Nose: Cherries with some spicy notes from the Cabernet.

Palate: : Cherries and raspberries on the palate with hints of mint. The wine is not overly sweet – a good balance between sweet and dry – it finishes clean and not cloying.

Notes: The Clare Wine Co Rose offers some body on the palate and good structure. It's not too sweet, and has a reasonably dry finish. Great with spicy foods or by itself on a hot day. Enjoy it now in its youth.
