

2010 Clare Wine Co Rose

Kaesler own vineyards in the Watervale and Polish Hill subregions of the Clare Valley.

The 2010 Clare Wine Co Rose is the first release from the Clare Valley estate, owned by Kaesler wines & the fruit is sourced from the Polish Hill vineyard.

The Clare Wine Co Rose is a blend of Shiraz (55%) and Cabernet Sauvignon (45%). The wine was cold soaked for 5 days before starting ferment and was then pressed off and finished in tank.

Colour: Ruby garnet.

Nose: Cherries with some spicy notes from the Cabernet.

Palate: Cherries and raspberries on the palate with hints of mint. The wine is not overly sweet – a good balance between sweet and dry – it finishes clean and not cloying.

Notes: The Clare Wine Co Rose offers some body on the palate and good structure. It's not too sweet, and has a reasonably dry finish. Great with spicy foods or by itself on a hot day. Enjoy it now in its youth.
