



2010 Clare Wine Co Shiraz

The 2010 Clare Wine Co Shiraz is the second release from the Clare Valley estate, owned by Kaesler wines. Kaesler own vineyards in the Watervale and Polish Hill sub-regions of the Clare Valley.

The Shiraz fruit to make this wine was sourced from the Watervale vineyard and was picked in early March. Fruit was picked and then transported to Kaesler in the Barossa Valley for processing. The wine was fermented at a medium temperature (26-30 Degrees centigrade) in stainless steel for 7 days and transferred to mainly older oak.

The 2010 Shiraz was matured in 10% new French oak and the balance 3 and 4 year old French oak barriques for 12 months. This has given a hint of oak but still allowing the fruit to dominate.

Colour: Vibrant cherry red.

Nose: Sweet dark red berries such as satsuma plums and mulberry.

Palate: A rich, sweet fruit palate that is fruit dominated with good length.

Notes: A very easy drinking style of wine. Enjoy now in its youth or over the next 5 years.

Alc: 15.0%
