

2010 Clare Wine Co Twosome

Kaesler own vineyards in the Watervale and Polish Hill subregions of the Clare Valley.

The 2010 Clare Wine Co Twosome is the first release from the Clare Valley estate, owned by Kaesler wines & the fruit is sourced from the Watervale vineyard.

Twosome is a blend of Semillon (63%) and Chardonnay (37%). The fruit was hand harvested and pressed at the same time here at the Kaesler winery in the Barossa – the perfect twosome. This vinification allows immediate integration of fruit flavours. The wine is un-oaked.

Colour: Pale straw colour.

Nose: Citrus notes with hints of white stonefruit.

Palate: Elegant palate weight from the Chardonnay – melon and slight pineapple notes with the grassier, refreshing flavours of the Semillon.

Notes: This wine is that "Classic Dry White" style of wine – easy drinking by itself or matched with the more subtle flavours of seafood – great with fish & chips to cut the greasy notes. Enjoy now in its youth or over the next 3 years.
