



2013 Clare Wine Co Cabernet Sauvignon

Kaesler own vineyards in the Watervale and Polish Hill sub-regions of the Clare Valley. The 2013 Clare Wine Co Cabernet is the sixth release from the Clare Valley estate, owned by Kaesler wines & the fruit is sourced from the Watervale & Polish Hill vineyard.

Fruit was picked and then transported to Kaesler in the Barossa Valley for processing. The wine was fermented at a medium temperature (26-30 Degrees centigrade) in stainless steel and transferred to mainly older oak.

The 2013 Cabernet was matured in 15% new French oak and the balance 3 and 4 year old French oak barriques for 12 months. This has given a hint of oak but still allowing the fruit to dominate.

Colour: Vibrant cherry red.

Nose: Chocolate mint characters on the nose.

Palate: Bright red berry fruits, with liquorice and aniseed notes. Supple with great length.

Notes: A very easy drinking style of wine. Enjoy now in its youth or over the next 5 years.
