

2013 Clare Wine Co Watervale Riesling

Kaesler own vineyards in the Watervale and Polish Hill subregions of the Clare Valley. The 2013 Clare Wine Co Riesling is the fourth release from the Clare Valley estate, owned by Kaesler wines & the fruit is sourced from the Watervale vineyard

Fruit was hand-picked at night then settled naturally without enzyme clarification. Fermented cool over 12 days left with natural yeasts. After the ferment the wines was left "sur lie" (on lees) for 4 months then bottled. No fining for structure on the palate.

Colour: Pale straw.

Nose: Fresh limes with hints of stone fruit notes such as nectarine.

Palate: Quite rich for a younger wine. Nice citrus flavours, lychees, with a bit of sugar, just to take the sting out of the acid. Mouth filling, well-structured palate.

Notes: A very easy drinking style of wine. An excellent drinks in its youth or will cellar for the next 5 -8 years. Being Riesling and a fuller style at that get it as cold as you can, and don't worry about it being too cold, you'll be on the patio, reclining in the Banana lounge, flicking from the tennis to the cricket.
