2013 Nashwauk Wrecked Shiraz

Grape Variety: 100% Shiraz

Vineyard Soils: Black/red Biscay clay over white slate

Vine Age: Shiraz sourced from three blocks aged 20 and 40 years old

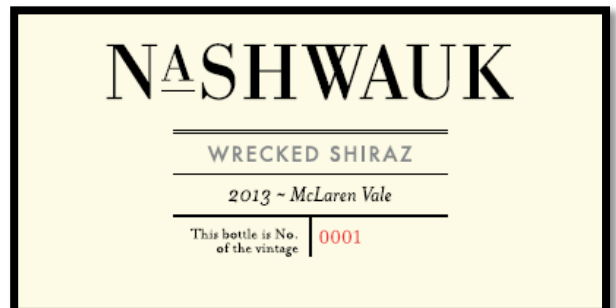

Summary:

Fruit was selected from two separate blocks on the Nashwauk property, vine age 20 and 40 year old. These two blocks have been used to make the Wrecked Shiraz since 2006, represent some of the finest Shiraz parcels on the Nashwauk property.

Vinification:

Harvesting for this wine was done in two picks, the first was by hand on the 12/02/2013 and the second was the 19/02/2013. Both parcels are fermented for 8 days on skins and gently pumped over twice a day or as needed. After pressing it's racked to 25% new French oak, with the balance being 2 and 3 year old for the next 24 months.



ALC 15.5% **pH** 3.75 **TA** 5.77 g/l

Tasting Note:

Colour: Dark cherry.

Nose: Dark black fruits, coffee and some cloves.

Palate: Concentrated blueberry, blackberry and plum with a twist of spice to help define and accentuate the fruit. Silky tannins and sweet fruit complete a sumptuous palate.

Note: This wine will age happily over the next 15 years. Estate grown.
