



2016 Clare Wine Co Rose

Kaesler own vineyards in the Watervale and Polish Hill sub-regions of the Clare Valley.

The 2016 Clare Wine Co Rose is the second release from the Clare Valley estate, owned by Kaesler Wines & the fruit is sourced from the Polish Hill vineyard.

The Clare Wine Co Rose has a starts it's life as Shiraz. But that's where Shiraz ends and the story of Rose begins. When you harvest Shiraz at only 11 baume as we did on the 16th February, we are looking for the right acid and color, than sweetness. The wine was cold soaked for ½ a day before very light pressing and starting the ferment, by doing this we are able to maintane the right amount of acity and color without the Tannins you would normaly get from Shiraz.

Colour: Rose Petal Pink.

Nose: Cherries, Strawberry and Watermelon.

Palate: Strawberry, Cherry and a hint of Peach Skin on the pallet. The wine is not overly sweet – a good balance between sweet and dry – it finishes clean.

Notes: The Clare Wine Co Rose is a clean, luscious and inviting. Great with spicy foods or by itself on a hot day. Enjoy it now in its youth.
